CANadda is very proud to offer the **Neurodiversity Alert Card/Wristband**. The cards/wristbands have been produced by us and are available **FREE** to our members who have a neurodiverse condition e.g. ASD, Dyslexia, Dyspraxia, ADD/ADHD (subject to sufficient proof being sent). By filling out our application form, this entitles you to free membership with CANadda.

The card/wristband should be carried at all times and can be displayed if the individual finds themselves in a situation where they cannot easily explain their behaviour. It will also assist the emergency services to identify that they are dealing with someone with a neurodiverse condition.

The card/wristband will carry CANadda's logo. The card will have the Lincolnshire Police crest so they will be easily identifiable to the emergency services. The card also gives some simple advice, the person's name and has space for two emergency contact details. The wristband has space for one emergency contact details.

If you, or someone you know would like a card or wristband, please complete the form overleaf and return to me at the above address with a **copy** of proof of your diagnosis, which will be returned to you. If you require CANadda to post your alert card/wristband back to you **please enclose a self addressed stamped envelope or a large letter rate stamp if requesting a wristband, or put a £1 coin in to help us cover costs.** Please note CANadda cannot be held responsible for any documentation that goes missing in the post.

If you require an extra card/wristband they will be £1.00 each and also there is a fee of £1.00 each for any replacement cards or wristbands. Cheques made payable to CANadda.
