

You will then be given opportunity to consider the five scenarios and to answer either 'yes' or 'no' each one. Next, you will be asked to explain why these particular choices were made and your explanations will be audio-taped. The audio recording tapes will be used only for research purposes. You will also be asked to fill in a questionnaire, measuring autism spectrum traits, and a few details about your (age and gender). You are free to withdrawn from the study at any point without explanation.
