that the person carrying the card or wearing a wristband has a condition that may require special attention.

Do you or a person you know have a Neurodiverse Condition?

Our credit card sized neurodiversity alert card can be carried at all times and can be displayed if you find yourself in a situation where you cannot easily give an explanation about your condition. Otherwise you may prefer to wear a wristband instead.

This card will also assist the police and emergency services to identify that they are dealing with someone who has a neurodiverse condition e.g. ASD, Dyslexia, Dyspraxia and ADD/ADHD.

The cards and wristbands will carry CANadda's logo. The card will have the Lincolnshire Police crest on it so it will be easily identifiable to the emergency services.

We are delighted that we can offer this card/wristband **FREE** of charge to our members and help raise awareness of neurodiversity amongst the public and emergency services.

The card also gives some simple advice, the cardholder's name and has space for two emergency contacts' details. The wristband will have space for one emergency contact number.

In addition to the card and wristband, CANadda is providing information and training to the Police and other emergency services to give them a better understanding of the alert card and wristband scheme.

You will need to fill in an application form and your card or wristband will then be sent to you as soon as possible, we require a self addressed stamped envelope to enable us to send it back to you in the post. By filling out our application form, this entitles you to free membership with CANadda.

If you require an extra card/wristband they will be £5.00 each and also there is a fee of £5.00 each for any replacement cards or wristbands. Cheques made payable to CANadda.

<u>Please note</u>: We need a *copy* of proof of the applicant having a Neurodiverse Condition, which we will send back to you, otherwise we regret we will be unable to process the application. Please note CANadda cannot be held responsible for any documentation that goes missing in the post.

Proof includes:

- Diagnosis Letter
- Statement of Special Educational Needs
- Letter from a professional e.g. Doctor/Social Worker etc.
